The AMAN-International Foundation equips the Police Station of the 30th Arrondissement of Deux-Plateaux

This Monday, March 17, 2008, the AMAN-International Foundation (FAI) offered an important donation of appliances, office supplies, household equipment and phytosanitary products to the Police Station of the 30th Arrondissement of the Ivorian economic metropolis. The handover of the donations took place in the new premises of the police located in Attoban, district of Deux-Plateaux in the town of Cocody.

After an important donation of clothes to the "Cellule de la Solidarité et de l'Action Humanitaire" (CSAH) of the Ministry of

This action, the first of its kind in this district of Abidjan, was welcomed with an explosion of joy not only by the police officers of the 30th district and in particular by Commissioner TASSÉRÉ, the representative of the police prefecture, but also by the delegation of the Ministry of Solidarity and Victims of War, the traditional chiefs of Gobelet, a precarious district of Attoban, and the members of various NGOs present at this ceremony of donation.
