On Friday, February 22, 2008, a delegation of the AMAN-International Foundation (FAI), led by the Founding President Marie Ginette AMANI, visited the "Solidarity and Humanitarian Action" Unit of the Ministry of Solidarity and Victims of War located in Deux Plateaux (Abidjan).

This visit is part of the research and strengthening of partnerships with institutions involved in humanitarian and development actions.

The AMAN-International Foundation has had a rich collaboration with the Ministry of Solidarity and Victims of War during 2007 on several of its major programs, such as the "Heart Cruise" (FAI-CdC), the "Humanitarian Corps" of the AMAN-International Foundation (FAI-CH) and the "International Humanitarian and Development Fair" (FAI-SIHD).

In order to remain faithful to its mission "Humanitarianism in everyday life", the AMAN-International Foundation has decided to get closer to the technical services in charge of humanitarianism in order to promote a better deployment of its actions in the field. According to Marie Ginette AMANI: "Humanitarian disasters are a daily reality in developing countries - as in Côte d'Ivoire. It is our perseverance and the combined efforts of all humanitarian actors that will make it possible to slightly reduce poverty and restore human dignity.

The AMAN-International Foundation was welcomed in the premises of the "Solidarity and Humanitarian Action Unit" (CSAH) of the Ministry, headed by the Minister of Solidarity and Victims of War, Louis André DACOURY-TABLEY, who wished to give this visit its official character.

The FAI delegation took part in a guided tour of the premises of this unit and learned about its missions and daily activities.

To materialize the collaboration between the Foundation and the Ministry, FAI made a symbolic donation of clothes that the unit will distribute to the needy families it has already identified.

This official visit took place in very good conditions to the great satisfaction of the Minister, the members of the cell and the delegation of the AMAN-International Foundation.
