

FAI's Founding President receives national distinction

The State of Côte d'Ivoire has elevated Marie Ginette AMANI to the rank of "Chevalier" in the Order of Merit of Solidarity of Côte d'Ivoire

Daloa (25.08. 2008) - This Monday was an unforgettable day for the AMAN-International Foundation (FAI) as it was the day of the decoration of the Founding President Marie Ginette AMANI accompanied by a delegation of FAI - alongside state personalities and officials of national institutions and international organizations - on the occasion of the official celebration of the third edition of the "National Day of Solidarity" (JNS) in Daloa, the capital city of the Haut-Sassandra region and of the Daloa department in the Centre-West of Côte d'Ivoire.
