The AMAN-International Foundation supports the actions of the GC-CI Network

Abidjan (29.09.2009) - The "Global Compact Network-Côte d'Ivoire" (GC-CI) organized a breakfast meeting at the Pullman Hotel - located at the Plateau in Abidjan - to which it invited the AMAN-International Foundation recently recognized by the central headquarters of this important United Nations organization in New York.

The AMAN-International Foundation thanks to its action and seriousness has succeeded in recent years to position itself at the institutional level. It has cooperated with several national and international public institutions, including several United Nations agencies.

Recently, the Global Compact headquarters in New York approved the AMAN-International Foundation (FAI) among the organizations belonging to its network presided over at the global level by the Secretary General of the United Nations. This recognition has also led to the systematic entry of the FAI into the Global Compact Côte d'Ivoire network which includes the largest companies and institutions in the country.
