Abidjan (22.02.2008) - A delegation of the AMAN-International Foundation (FAI), led by its Founding President Marie Ginette AMANI, has undertaken a visit to the "Solidarity and Humanitarian Action" Unit of the Ministry of Solidarity and Victims of War (MSVG) located at Deux Plateaux (Vallon) in Abidjan.

This visit is part of the research and strengthening of partnerships with institutions involved in humanitarian and development actions.

The representatives of the FAI were given a guided tour of the premises of this unit and were informed of its missions and daily activities.

To materialize the collaboration between the Foundation and the Ministry, the FAI made a symbolic donation of clothes that the cell will distribute to the needy families it has already identified.
