The Founding President of the FAI receives a delegation of war displacements at her office in Abidjan

Abidjan (07.12.2011) - The Founding President of the AMAN-International Foundation (FAI) received in audience a series of civil society actors including the leaders of ADERG-CI (Association for War Displaced Persons of Côte d'Ivoire).

Having known the AMAN-International Foundation for several years and having benefited from FAI's assistance programs (training in micro-projects, financing of micro-projects for its members, psychosocial counseling), the leaders of ADERG-CI wished to meet with the Founding President of FAI in order to give a report on the progress of their activities.

This meeting with the President of ADERG-CI allowed the members of this association to introduce their grievances to the FAI concerning the need for ADERG-CI members to benefit from new funds to strengthen or initiate new individual micro-projects, but especially on the need for the families of this association of war displacements to benefit from housing for each of them.

The President of the AMAN-International Foundation reassured that she would not hesitate to bring their grievances to the competent authorities capable of responding to such an expectation within the framework of the factors of the crisis - or even the war that Côte d'Ivoire has experienced.

The President recalled that the AMAN-International Foundation worked essentially on its own funds; she stressed that the requests were more and more numerous so that a support of external donors would be welcome to help the Foundation to relieve a greater number of applicants.
